Program Duration: 12 Months

<u>Course Structure:</u> 12 courses over 12 months in two semesters and an independent research project <u>Study Days: Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays</u>

Program Cost and Tuition: The complete cost of the programme is \$ 3500, which covers:

- <u>A non-refundable Enrolment fee: \$500</u>
- MA tuition fee: \$3.000
- Per Term Extension charge (If you don't finish in time (12 months) nd anything more 18 months): \$1000 per term

Programme costs are paid as follows:

- A non-refundable Admin and Enrolment1 fee: \$500 (payable in 2 installments of \$250)
- First Semester 50% tuition fee: \$1.500
- Second Semester 50% tuition fee: \$1.500
- Failure to graduate on time will attract an Extension Charge: \$1000
- PhD Program Tuition Fees: \$20,000
